Welcome to Cohuna Waterfront Holiday Park

The following information and guidelines are provided to ensure visitors to our park have an enjoyable stay.

1. Fees

Please ensure that all fees are paid in advance.

2. Check In/Check Out

Site fees are calculated until 10.00am on the day of departure. If your travel arrangements are inconvenienced by these times please contact Park Management to make alternative arrangements. Site check in 11.00am and on-site accommodation check in from 2.00pm.

3. Vehicles

The safety of our customers is of prime importance. You can assist our cause by limiting the speed of your vehicle to 5 kilometres (walking pace) whilst within the Park. Please contact the Park Management if you wish to wash or repair a vehicle on site.

4. Pets

You are welcome to bring pets, however this is restricted to one per site, please ensure that they are well behaved, are kept on a leash and that you are responsible for them at all times. No pets are allowed in any on-site accommodation.

5. Children

The park and its facilities are provided for the enjoyment of you and your children. The supervision of your children is important for their safety and to ensure they do not disturb other people in the park. Children must be accompanied by an adult when visiting the showers and toilets.

6. Scooters, Skateboards, Roller Skates and Roller Blades

Park Management will provide information to guests regarding the nearest safe area available for children to use skateboards, roller skates, etc. For the benefit of our customers these items are not to be used within the park grounds. Bicycles may be ridden in the park during

daylight hours providing the rider is wearing a safety helmet.

7. Bicycles

Bicycles may only be ridden on shared roadways, not on grassed areas or pathways and only in daylight hours. Safety helmets must be worn at all times.

8. Swimming Pool & Jumping Pillow

Opening time – 8.00am. Closing time at Managers Discretion. Children must be supervised at ALL times. Pool & Pillow rules must be followed at all times. We are not responsible for any accidents or injuries.

9. Your Site

Please keep your site tidy and use the facilities provided for drying clothes, discharge of sullage water and rubbish disposal. Please do not dig trenches on or around your site. Unfortunately no open fires are permitted under local law.

10. Noise

The peaceful enjoyment of our park and its facilities by all visitors is important to us. Please assist by being considerate to your neighbours and restrict noise from radios, televisions and social gatherings after 10pm at night and before 6am.

11. Telephone Messages

Messages will be placed on the notice boards except for urgent messages, which will be delivered to your site.

12. Securing your Site

While Park Management do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, it is recommended that visitors to Cohuna Waterfront Holiday Park take the precaution of securing items of value left outside their tent, caravan or cabin during the day and overnight.
