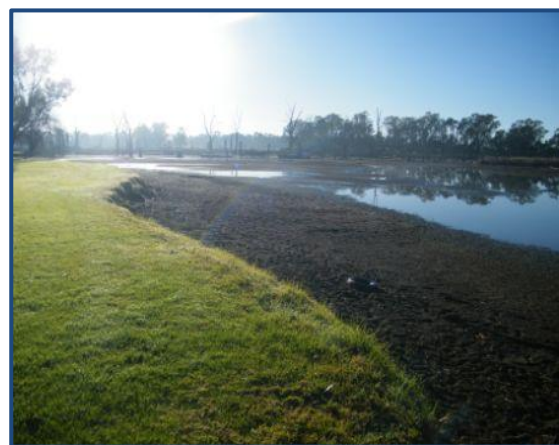
Manager's message
