The following information and guidelines are provided to ensure visitors to our park have an enjoyable stay.

1. Fees

Please ensure that all fees are paid in advance.

2. Check In/Check Out

Site fees are calculated until 10am on the day of departure. If your travel arrangements are inconvenienced by these times please contact Park Management to make alternative arrangements. Site check in 11am and on-site accommodation check in from 2pm.

3. Vehicles

The safety of all our guests and children is utmost. We'd appreciate your diligence in keeping vehicle speed to walking pace only. Please contact Management if you wish to wash or repair a vehicle on site. Vehicles, boats, jet skis etc. must not encroach over roadways or adjoining sites.

4. Pets

You are welcome to bring your well behaved pets, restricted to 1 per site. Remember to have their leads attached at all times and that it is your responsibility to clean up after them (poop bags available at reception) and to never leave them unattended. Due to health regulations and allergies, no pets are allowed in the cabins, office, pool, jumping pillow or camp kitchen.

5. Children

The park and its facilities are provided for the enjoyment of you and your children. The supervision of your children is important for their safety and to ensure they do not disturb other people in the park. Children must be accompanied by an adult when visiting the showers and toilets.

6. Bikes, Scooters, Skateboards, Roller Skates & Roller Blades

Park patrons are responsible for their children at all times. Bikes, skateboards and scooters must be ridden with extreme care:

- No riding around amenity blocks.
- Speed limit and other road signs must be obeyed at all times.
- As required by bike law, helmets must be worn.
- No riding after streetlights are on at night.

Management cannot accept responsibility for any injuries incurred through accidents whilst in the park.

7. Jumping Pillow

Use of jumping pillows may result in serious personal injury including death, head, eye or spinal injury, paralysis, broken limbs or strains. Flips, somersaults and inverted manoeuvres are dangerous and prohibited. Other risks include falls and collisions with other users. Not to be used when wet.

8. Playground

Use of playground equipment may result in serious personal injury including death, head, eye or spinal injury, paralysis, broken limbs or strains. Risks include falls and collisions with other users and hazards associated with gaps, openings and protruding objects.

9. Swimming Pool

Use of swimming pools and associated facilities may result in serious personal injury including death, drowning, head, eye or spinal injury, paralysis, broken limbs or strains. Flips, somersaults and inverted manoeuvres into the water are dangerous and prohibited. Other risks include diving head first, slips, trips, falls, running on wet surfaces and not providing adequate supervision to children.

10. Your Site

Please keep your site tidy and use the facilities provided for drying clothes, discharge of sullage water and rubbish disposal. Please do not dig trenches on or around your site. Unfortunately no open fires are permitted under local law. No generators permitted.

11. Noise

The peaceful enjoyment of our park and its facilities by all visitors is important to us. Please assist by being considerate to your neighbours and restrict noise from radios, televisions and social gatherings after 10pm at night and before 7am.

12. Telephone Messages

Messages will be placed on the notice boards except for urgent messages, which will be delivered to your site.

13. Securing your Site

While Park Management do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, it is recommended that visitors to Cohuna Waterfront Holiday Park take the precaution of securing items of value left outside their tent, caravan or cabin during the day and overnight. Any suspicious behaviour should be reported to the manager.
